


Futurepark Property Fund "FUTUREPF"

Performance Summary

1Q 2008 Performance: The Fund had Total Income of Baht 160.4 million, Net Investment Income of Baht 115.2 million, and Distributable Income of Baht 127.3 million which equal to 24% of its projection in year 2008 and are closed to the performance in the same period of last year. The Fund also announced a dividend payment for 1Q2008 of Baht 0.243 per unit which equals to the rate of return of 9.72% (Annualized)*


NAV increased 3.6% from IPO price. As of March 31, 2008 the Fund had Net Asset Value of Baht 4,904.7 million or Baht 10.3623 per unit.





Management Discussion & Analysis

Total Income

FUTUREPF showed total income in 1Q2008 of Baht 160.4 million, equaled to 23% of 2008 projection. Total income increased 1% compared to the same period of last year, which total income was Baht 159.0 million.

Total Expenses

Total expenses for 1Q2008 were Baht 45.2 million, equaled to 21% of 2008 projection. Total expenses decreased by 8% compared to the same period of last year, which total expenses were Baht 49.0 million.

Distributable Income

In 1Q2008, FUTUREPF recorded net investment income of Baht 115.2 million. Distributable income equaled Baht 127.3 million, which equaled to 24% of 2008 projection. Dividend payment for this quarter equaled to Baht 115.0 million, or Baht 0.243 per unit.

Net investment income and distributable income increased 5% and 4% respectively compared to the same period of last year. Distribution income increase 1% compared to the same period of last year.

Balance Sheet

Total assets of FUTUREPF equaled Baht 5,199.6 million, and liabilities of Baht 294.9 million, comprising deposits received from tenants and other account payables. Net asset value (NAV) totaled Baht 4,904.7 million, equaled to NAV per unit of Baht 10.3623, decreasing 1% from December 31, 2007.

Profitability

In 1Q2008, FUTUREPF showed net investment income margin of 72% of total income, distributable income margin of 79% of total income, and distribution income margin of 72% of total income, which are higher than 2008 projection and the same period of last year.

Renovation and Capital Expenditure

In 1Q/2008, FUTUREPF renovated their rental space and common space in compliance with the marketing concept of the Natural - Metro Shopping Park. The Harmony of Nature... Modern Life...and You. Total capital expenditure in this quarter was Baht 74.6 million.





2.Traffic Performance







More convenient traffic to Future Park Rangsit

Progress on Rangsit Expressway Project 2nd Phase The Rangsit Expressway Project 2nd Phase is being progressed. The project aims to reduce the traffic congestion in front of the store and to provide traffic convenience for the people traveling between Bangkok - Central - Northern - Northeastern routes. The services are partly be available for use and expected

to be completed in June 2008.

Yellow Line

Those who travel from Saraburi can use the expressway directly heading to Pathumthani.

Those who travel from Rangsit-Nakhon Nayok can use the expressway directly heading to Pathumthani. (Also, the line directs to Nakhon Nayok-Saraburi will be available for service in June 2008)

Those who travel from Rangsit-Nakhon Nayok can direct to Toll way via Expressway (blue line) heading to Bangkok.

In June 2008, Future Park Rangsit's customers will find it more convenient traveling to the store by using the red line. They can use the Don Muang - Toll Way heading to the store through the Remembrance Monument Checkpoint heading to Bangpa-in following Nakhon-Nayok sign. 
